The meeting started at 7:06pm. Dori Holt presided.

The program was presented by Pat Yearwood from Stitch 'n' Quilt. She showed us some new rulers, kits and "gifty" items from the quilt store. Sara and Jackie showed how to use the new rulers for strip piecing, quilt as you go and making cording. It was a great program. The "fun frenzy" began when we were given a chance to buy things from her shop.
